

Spring Picture Charades



Are you looking for a fun activity that will get your students moving this spring? This kid-friendly version of charades is designed for students who benefit from visual support. Students take turns acting out a picture (animal, action, sport, etc) and the other group members try to guess which one it is. Traditionally, only hand gestures and movements are allowed but in my experience, younger students might need to use sound effects.
